

## **Table Tents and Holy Cards**

*Explanation:* Using the last page of *Praying for Vocations for 5 Minutes for 7 Days* which can be found under the tab, *Traveling Crucifix* use the "Family Prayer for Vocations" or make up your own family prayer for vocations. Type on paper and take to print company and have them make table tents for you. Take the same prayer and a favorite religious picture and have it made into a holy card. There are several places on the website to find pictures for a Holy Card. Make sure the pictures are not copyrighted. The best practice is to use a company that specializes in Holy Cards or Prayer Cards.

*Steps:*

### **TABLE TENTS:**

1. Look at back cover of *Praying for Vocations for 5 Minutes for 7 Days* which can be found under the tab, *Traveling Crucifix*. Use the "Family Prayer for Vocations" or make up your own family prayer for vocations.
2. Take prayer to a print company and have them make a table tent. A table tent is where the prayer is written once right side up and then upside down with the first line of the text next to each other. In this way, when the fold is made between the two first lines of the text, and the paper is stood up, the prayer is right side up on both sides of the table tent.
3. The print company will ask what color of paper? Anything but white. They will also ask about color of ink; black is ok, and is the cheapest.

### **HOLY CARDS:**

1. In almost every religious goods book, they sell holy cards. Buy enough cards for each parishioner.
2. Take the Holy Card to a print company (and it may be the religious goods book company where you got the Holy Card) and have them print your prayer on the back of the card.
3. Give the cards out to each parishioner. Have extras in the pews to pray at mass and other gatherings. (it may be good to have the prayer taped inside the cover of the hymnal.)
4. Pray it at Mass:  
Close the General Intercessions with the prayer  
Prayer after the Priests sits down from distributing communion  
Any other suitable time.
